It prohibits dispensing or selling more than a day supply of the drug. Apr 19, - This federal legislation is modeled after laws in several states. New Jersey recently passed a law limiting initial opioid prescriptions for acute pain to 5 days, as reported by Medscape Medical News. New Jersey's 5-day limit is the strictest in the nation.
