Stronger painkillers, such as the opiates hydrocodone (in Vicodin) and oxycodone (in Percocet), which are used to manage pain after a vaginal delivery or cesarean section, can also be suitable if you use them as prescribed and monitor your baby. Fifty mothers who delivered by cesarean section and received oxycodone had milk (colostrum) and serum samples measured for oxycodone at 24, 48 and 72 hours postpartum without respect to the time of the previous oxycodone dose. The most common doses received by the mothers during the previous 24 hours. Jul 7, - An excess of breast milk contaminated with oxycodone and acetaminophen could cause sedation, lethargy and respiratory issues in infants. If the mother is taking large doses of Percocet during breastfeeding, and is taking the drug for a prolonged period of time, there may be a significant risk to the infant. Also, medications used in the first three to four days after childbirth transfer at very low levels to an infant, due to the limited volume of breast milk you're producing.
